Accelerated Certificate Programs

Minimum Requirements:

- A university degree and/or substantial experience in an area related to the certificate you wish to pursue
- A minimum score of 71 on the iBT TOEFL, 530 on the PBT TOEFL, 710 on the TOEIC, 6.0 on the IELTS, or other evidence of advanced English language proficiency
- Consent of the Admissions Committee
- Additional requirements for some certificate programs (Please inquire)

All certificate programs at UC Irvine Extension require professional-level English language proficiency in listening and note-taking, reading comprehension and vocabulary, written expression, and oral presentation. International students who do not meet certificate program admissions requirements are invited to enroll first in one of our English language program offerings.





