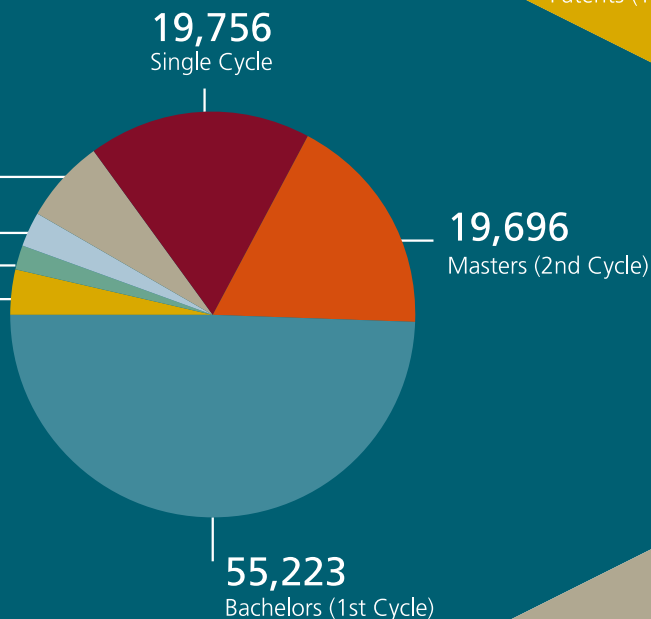

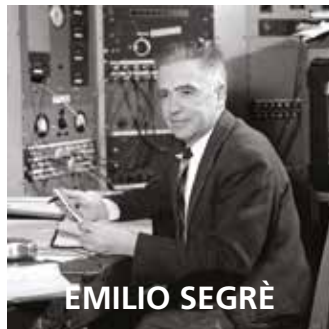

# Sapienza Nobel Prizes



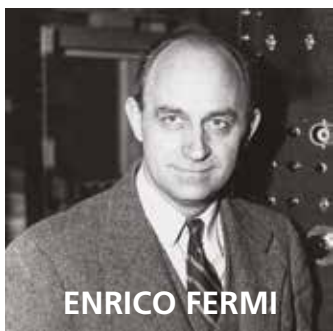
1909 Nobel Prize for Physics;

taught Physics 1928-1935



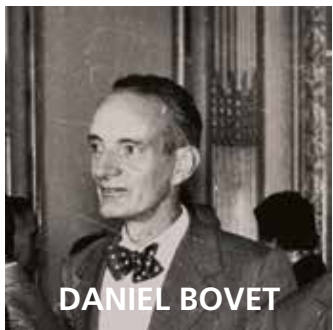
1985 Nobel Prize for Economics;
