Art. 1 – COURSE ACTIVATION

The application form for admission to the Summer School in Health Economics and Econometrics (SSHEE) and the Study Plan are available on the webpage ([Summer School in Health Economics and Econometrics \(SSHEE\) | Sapienza Università di Roma \(uniroma1.it\)](#)).

The course grants up to 4 ECTS.

Art. 2 - ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A Bachelor's Degree is required to access the course.

Art. 3 - PRE-ENROLLMENT APPLICATION

To apply, candidates must follow the instructions below:

a) On-line registration at Sapienza (Infostud)

Candidates must register at <https://www.studenti.uniroma1.it/phoenixreg/#/> and obtain a student ID number and a password, to access the information system of the University (Infostud). If the candidates are or were student at Sapienza, they should already have a student ID number. If the candidates do not remember the student ID number or password they can use the Infostud recovery procedure at the page <https://www.studenti.uniroma1.it/phoenix/#/recuperaPassword>.

The ID number must be indicated in the application for admission to the Course.

Please note: Any communication will be sent to the e-mail address indicated at the time of registration on Infostud. Candidates are recommended to check the accuracy of the e-mail address entered. Students already registered on Infostud must check/enter their email address using the User data > edit access data function.

b) Applications:

To be considered for admission, candidates must

- (i) fill in the application form (Attachment 1), including the student ID number, readable signature and a photocopy of a valid identity document (Identity Card - Car Driving License - Passport);
- (ii) submit a short CV and motivation letter (Attachment 2)
- (iii) indicate their education qualification on the Infostud profile (after accessing Infostud, click on "Profile" and "University degrees");



Candidates with qualifications obtained abroad must also submit one of the following:

- Declaration, issued by the Italian consular authority of the country of study with transcript of records + copy of the final diploma or
- CIMEA Certificate of Comparability accompanied by CIMEA Verification Certificate (by accessing the CIMEA platform: <http://www.cimea.it/it/servizi/attestati-di-comparabilita-e-certificazione-dei-titoli/attestati-di-comparabilita-e-di-verifica-dei-titoli-diplome.aspx>) or
- Diploma Supplement (in the case of a European qualification) issued by the University of origin and legalised at the Italian Embassy in the country of study.

Candidates with recognition of disability pursuant to art. 3, paragraphs 1 and 3, of law no.104 of 1992 and / or with a disability equal to or greater than 66%, are required to include:

- a copy of the disability certificate. The certificate must also be sent to sportellodisabili@uniroma1.it and to altaformazione@uniroma1.it.

Applications with incomplete documentation, or submitted after the deadline, will not be considered.

c) Deadline for application:

Applications must be submitted, together with the required documents, by **June 20th 2023** to the e-mail address sshee.ecodir@uniroma1.it.

Art. 4 –STUDENTS ADMITTED

After verification of the admission requirements, students admitted will be notified by email by **June 30th 2023**. They can then proceed to enrol by paying the registration fee, as indicated in Article 6 of this call.

Art. 5 - ENROLMENT FEE

The required fee for participation to the Summer School is of **€ 350 plus a stamp duty of € 16.00** to be paid no later than **July 31st, 2023**. A limited number of scholarships will be offered to students from Sapienza for partial or total coverage of the enrolment fee.

Students with a recognised disability equal to or greater than 66% or with a recognised handicap pursuant to art. 3, paragraphs 1 and 3, of the law of 5 February 1992, n. 104 are exempt from 50% of the registration fee. To benefit from the reduction, students must send the documentation certifying their disability to sportellodisabili@uniroma1.it and to altaformazione@uniroma1.it

The enrolment fee can be refunded only, and exclusively, in the event the course is not activated.

Art. 6 - PAYMENT OF THE ENROLMENT FEE

The students admitted to the course must access Infostud2.0 from the page

with their ID number and password, click on "TRAINING COURSES", then click on "TAXES - Enrollment", enter the course code indicated in this call and follow the instructions.

The enrolment fee must be paid no later than **July 31st, 2023**, through the form downloaded from Infostud as described on the web page of Sapienza institutional site:

Teacher's Card: Permanent teachers of educational institutions of all levels can pay up to € 350.00 through the use of the so-called "Teacher's Card". In this case, after the deadline indicated in art. 2, the participant admitted to the course must write to the e-mail address altaformazione@uniroma1.it attaching the bonus generated by the MIUR site to receive by e-mail, a form to pay the difference, if due, between the enrollment fee and the amount of the bonus.

Loans by a company: To finance the enrolment of one or more people, the beneficiaries of the loan must register on



Infostud and obtain the form (point 5). The company must contact altaformazione@uniroma1.it to receive the details of the payment transfer. A copy of the payment (including company name, VAT number/tax code, contact details, name, surname, and registration number of the beneficiary/beneficiaries) must be sent to settoreentrate@uniroma1.it. After the payment has been verified, the University office issues a receipt for the amount paid and sends it to the mail address indicated in Infostud and in the application form.

Art. 7 - DURATION AND ORGANISATION OF THE ACTIVITIES

The course duration is 3 days. The lectures will start on the 5th of October 2023 and will end on the 7th of October 2023.

The overall duration of the activities is 24 hours.

Students attending at least 80% of the lectures will receive a certificate of attendance, which can be used to require recognition up to 4 ECTS.

In the event of non-attendance, or other behavior that is however reprehensible, the Program Coordinator may decide not to issue the certificate of attendance. In this case, the registration fee paid will not be refunded.

Art. 8 - PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Legal basis and purpose of the processing.

Pursuant to art. 6 of the Regulation, the processing of data is necessary for the performance of a task of public interest or connected to the exercise of public authority vested in the data controller. In particular, the data provided will be collected and processed for the pursuit of the following purposes:

Nature of the provision of data and consequences of any refusal

The provision of data is mandatory. Any refusal to provide data implies the impossibility for the Data Controller, the Manager and the persons in charge of conducting the data processing operations and, therefore, the impossibility of proceeding with the registration to the competition and the management of the activities related procedures.

Methods of processing and subjects authorized for processing

Data collection occurs in compliance with the principles of relevance, completeness and non-excessiveness in relation to the purposes for which they are processed.

Rights of the interested party

In case of violation of the provisions of the Regulations, the interested party may lodge a complaint with the Guarantor for the protection of personal data.
