

RIS4CIVIS launched – January 2021

The 3-year project was awarded a 2 million euros budget by the European Commission under the Horizon 2020 "Science with and for Society" programme.

The **project "RIS4CIVIS"** will support the Research and Innovation dimension of the CIVIS European University in line with its shared, integrated, long-term strategy and in synergy with its education dimension.

- based on a common vision and shared values to reach a sustainable high level of cooperation,
- sharing of practices, expertise, platforms, data and resources through the implementation by common structures
- transposing the CIVIS strategy into an Institutional Transformation Model serving as a source of inspiration for other European Alliances and/or Universities wishing to engage in R&I cooperation as well as for the European Commission in designing its future programmes and policy, by removing fragmentation, regulatory or legal barriers and by

fostering optimisation of R&I resources

CIVIS3i - COFUND

The **CIVIS** Alliance Programme for *International, Interdisciplinary, Intersectoral Research and Training for Experienced Researchers*

The CIVIS3i COFUND project has been selected by the European Commission under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions - Horizon 2020 programme in February 2021 to offer postdoctoral career training to talented young researchers within CIVIS.

The CIVIS3i project will offer to 32 excellent, innovative researchers - through two calls for applications - a 24-month postdoctoral fellowship that will enhance their career development and carry out excellent research projects within CIVIS key focus areas.

This project is co-funded by four CIVIS member universities: Aix-Marseille Université, Université libre de Bruxelles, the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid and the Sapienza University of Rome, and has a total budget of around 4.4 million euros.

The other CIVIS member-universities are associated to CIVIS 3i.
