#### Vision






### Structure








#### Study in Foreign Languages

  - √ 3,500 articles indexed in Web of Science written by CU scientists
  - ✓ h-index value of 76 at CU



### Cooperation with Italy

- 9 Inter-university agreements
- I 68 Erasmus+ bilateral agreements with 52 Italian universities and institutions
  - I36 incoming students and 64 outgoing students (2017/2018)
  - 84 incoming staff and 210 outgoing staff (2016/2017)
- Cooperation in UNICA, Coimbra Group, EUA, EUF and LERU
- Currently 88 full-time students with Italian citizenship



### Cooperation with Sapienza University of Rome

- Inter-university agreement (signed 1990)
- II Erasmus+ bilateral agreements
  - 9 incoming students and 6 outgoing students
