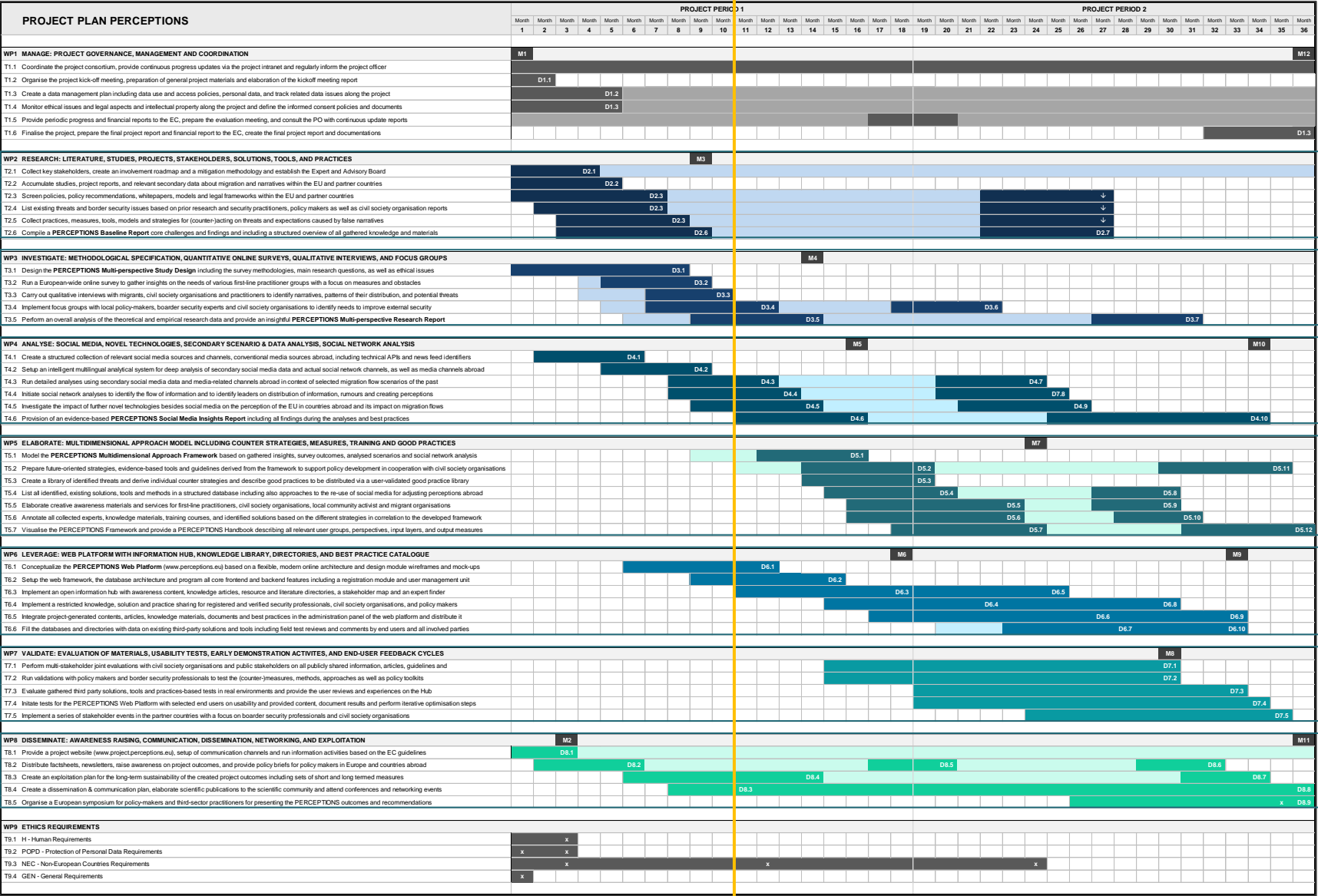

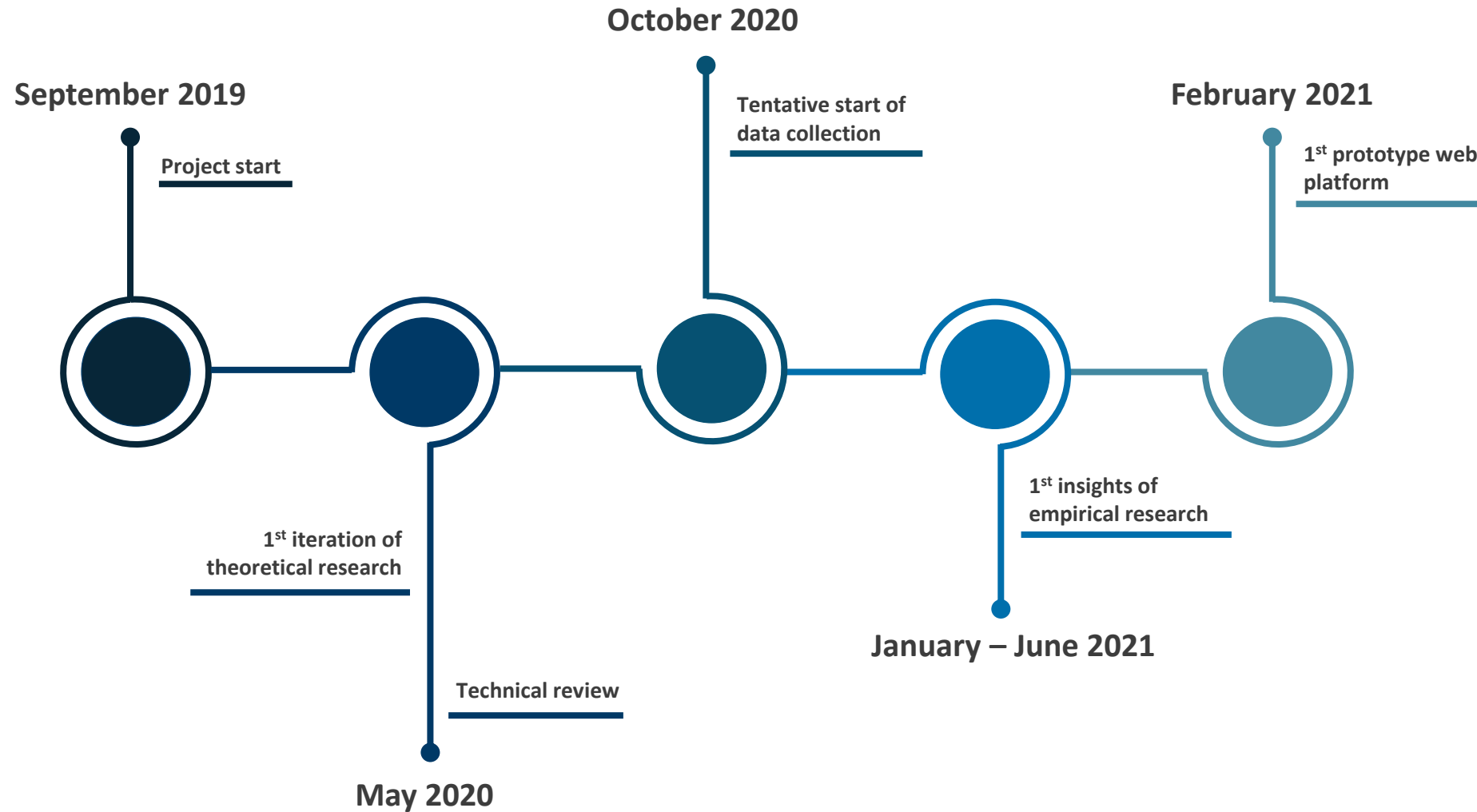

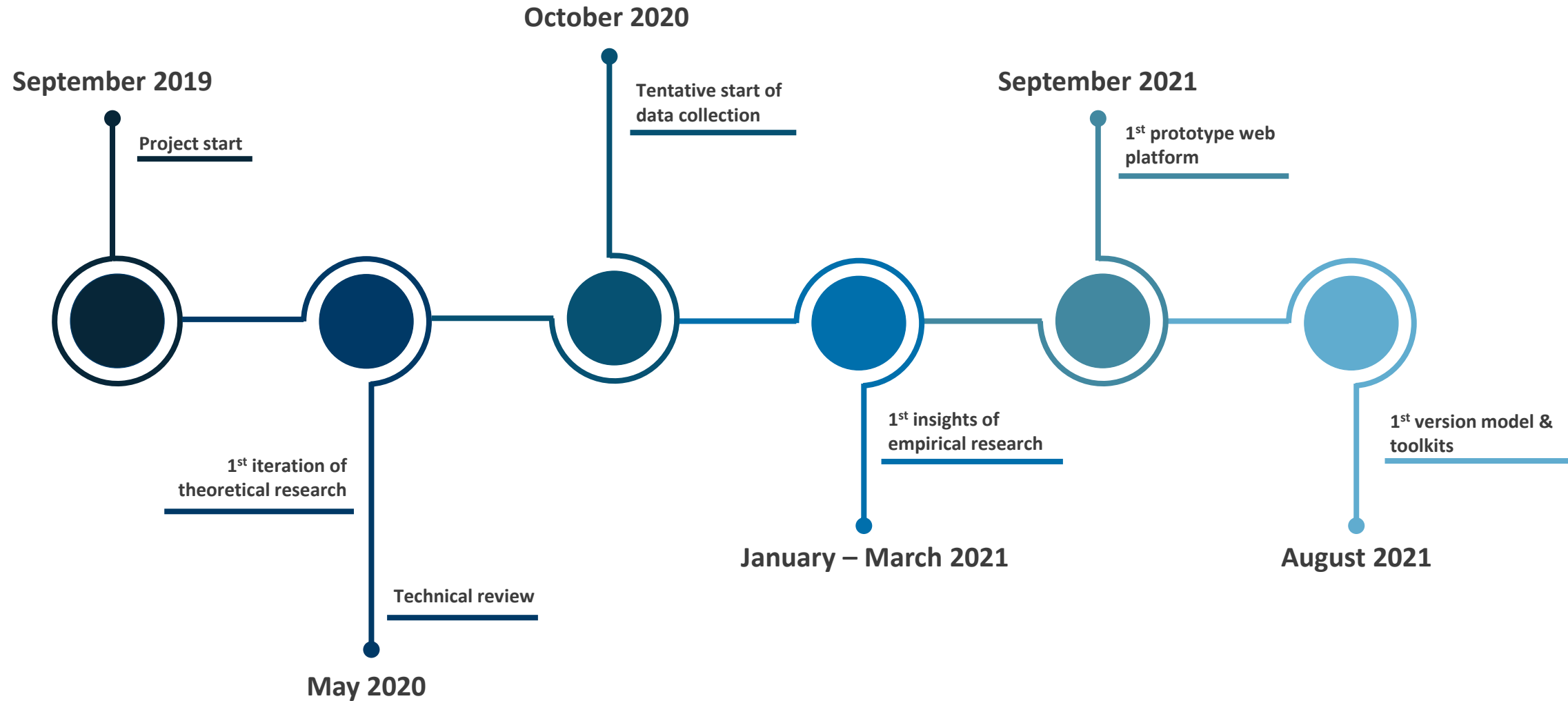

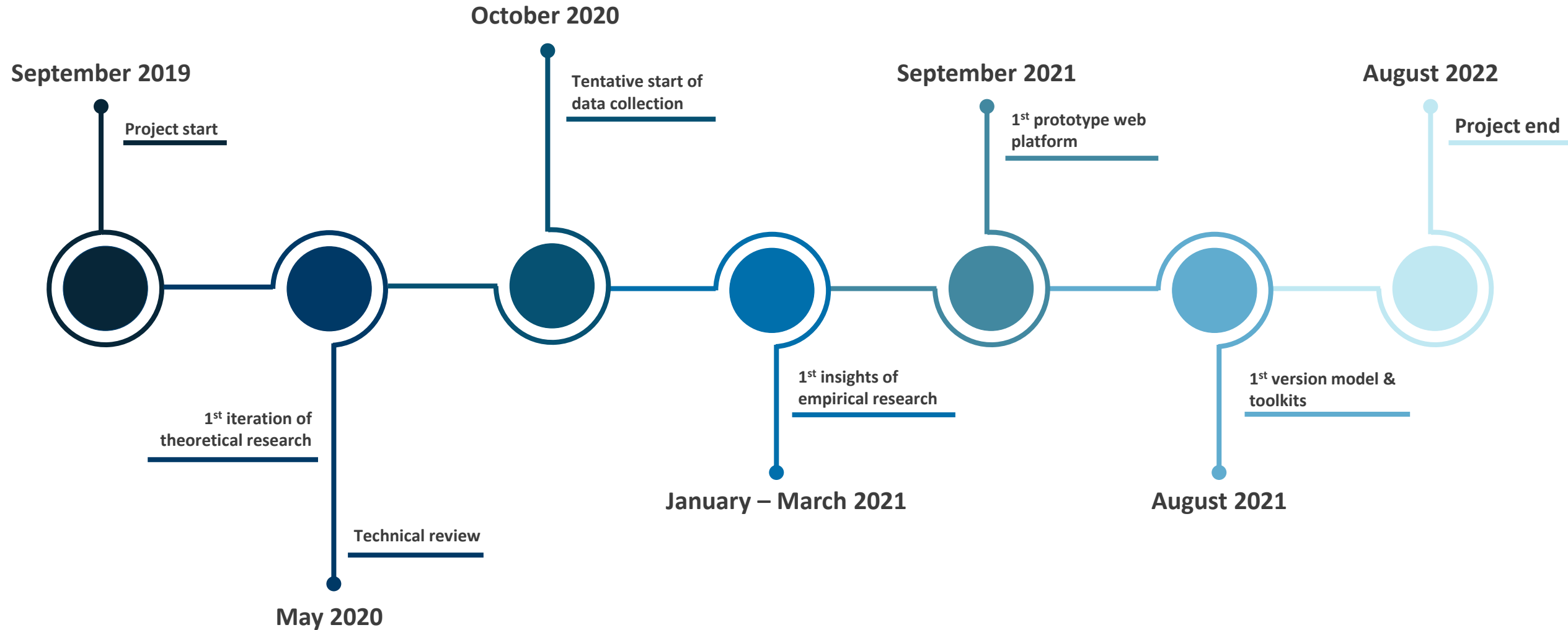

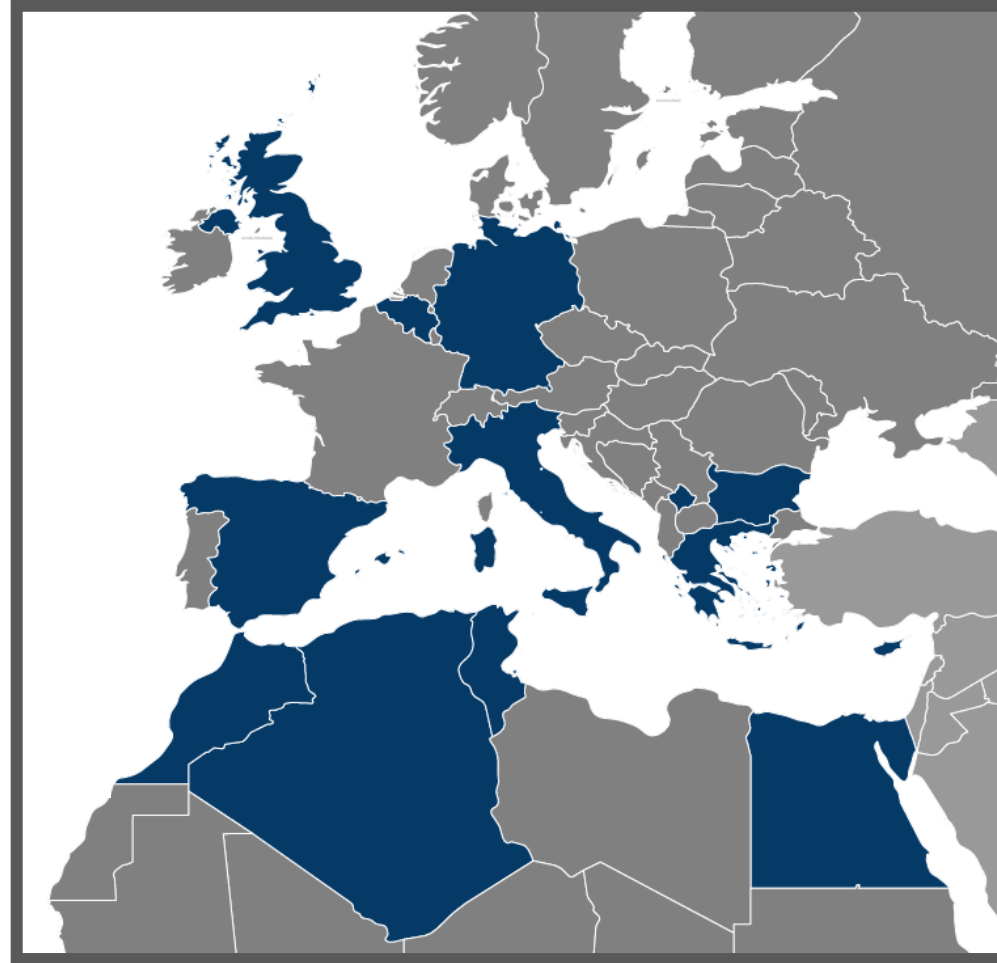

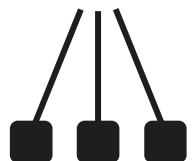

Dataset 1 – Twitter and mainstream media



Collection of tweets and news articles in 6 languages based on selected migration-related keywords (e.g. “#migration”, “border control”, “harraga”) through SYNYO’s platform



Topic modelling algorithm applied to multilingual dataset

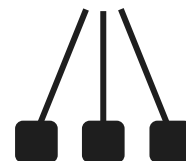


Comparison of topics discussed across stakeholder groups, languages, and media channels

Dataset 2 – Mainstream media articles



Select relevant events to retrieve news articles in multiple languages from multiple countries using GDELT



Analysis of GDELT data, including volume of media coverage, and further analysis including themes, elements of sentiment analysis and word use



Comparison of coverage between countries and over time – themes, types of language used, quantity of coverage

Expected outcomes
