



**INFORMATION NOTICE IN COMPLIANCE WITH ART. 13 OF THE EU REGULATION NO. 679/2016 OF APRIL 27, 2016 “GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION”**

**Processing purposes and legal basis**

The processing of personal data is aimed at performing all the accomplishments linked to the gathering of the opinion of bodies and enterprises having curricular or non-curricular internship/stage agreements.

**Nature of personal data conferral and consequence of a possible refusal**

The conferral of personal data is mandatory for the identification of the body/enterprise and for the proper matching to the trainees’ study programme. Failure to obtain personal data will trigger the exclusion from such survey.

**Processing methods and authorised subjects**

The personal data processing is carried out, according to an IT procedure, by personnel appointed by Sapienza Academic Programmes and Right to Education Area.

All the processed data will be exclusively used to carry out such survey and to gather the opinion of bodies and enterprises having curricular or non-curricular internship/stage agreements and will be communicated in an aggregate and anonymous form.

In no event will the provided data be processed for advertising, direct selling, market surveys or marketing purposes.

**Rights of the data subjects**

Data subjects have the right to obtain from the data controller or the data protection officer, whenever the conditions are met, the access to personal data in accordance with art. 15 of the Regulation, their rectification in accordance with art. 16 of the Regulation, their erasure in accordance with art. 17 of the Regulation or the restriction to personal data processing in accordance with art. 18 of the Regulation, or they may object to personal data processing in accordance with art. 21 of the Regulation, besides the right to data portability in accordance with art. 20 of the Regulation.

In the event of infringement of the Regulation provisions, data subjects may lodge a complaint to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data.
